This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because this action exceeds established reprogramming thresholds. Specifically, this reprogramming action realigns \$350.0 million within the Joint Improvised Explosive Device Defeat Fund, 11/13, appropriation. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: Funds are required for the following critical efforts:

- \$134.2 million to continue development and deploy a High Spectral Imaging initiative in order to disrupt the improvised explosive device supply chain and
- \$215.8 million to develop and deploy validated and emerging Joint Urgent Operations Needs (JUONs) focused on attacking the network of explosive device makers, suppliers, and emplacements.
