SUBJECT: Interim Change to the DoDFMR, Volume 7A, Regarding Permanent Increase to
Hostile Fire/Imminent Danger Pay (DFAS Item N-47)

Attached is Interim Change **13-05** to Chapter 10 of the Department of Defense Financial Management Regulation (DoDFMR), Volume 7A. It is effective October 28, 2004. This change makes the temporary increase of Hostile Fire/Imminent Danger Pay to \$225 a permanent increase.

This is a routine change and the result of directed action that does not affect existing policies. A draft of this change was not provided for comments. Assignment of the interim change number is your authority to initiate a procedural modification to implement this change. Use the attached to initiate the formal change to the DoDFMR, Volume 7A

PERMANENT INCREASE TO HOSTILE FIRE/IMMINENT DANGER PAY**1. Revise paragraph 100102 to read as follows:**

100102. Payment. Effective October 1, 2002, HF/IDP is payable at a monthly rate of \$225. It is payable in addition to all other pays or allowances. Additionally, it is payable in the full amount without being prorated or reduced, for each month, during any part of which, a member qualifies. Active and Reserve Component members who qualify, at any time during a month, will receive the full amount of HFP/IDP regardless of the actual period of time served on active or inactive duty during that month.

2. Revise the Bibliography for Chapter 10 as follows:

a. Delete all existing citations of public law as they have either been codified in 37 U.S.C. 310 or have expired.

b. Add the following citation to paragraph 100102:
