Special Initial Clothing Allowance

1. Replace subparagraph 290204.B with the following:

B. In pay grade E-6 or below, upon assignment to either the United States Navy Band, Washington, DC, or the United States Naval Academy Band or selection for temporary appointment as a Limited Duty Officer in the Navy.

2. Replace the description in column A, rules 1 and 2 of Table 29-2 with the following:

in pay grade E-6 or below and assigned to the Navy Band, Washington, DC, or the US Naval Academy Band or selected for temporary appointment as a Limited Duty Officer in the Navy.

3. For clarification, replace the first line of the description in column A, rules 5 and 6 of Table 29-2 with the following:

selected for officer training in the Navy and enters...
