1. Revise paragraph 060102 to read:

"Rates Payable The monthly rates payable are:"

2. Revise the amounts in paragraph 060102A thru 060102C to read:

A. 250.00

B. 583.33

C. 583.33

3. Revise paragraph 060202 to read:

"Rates Payable The monthly rates payable are:"

A. If the officer has less than 10 years  
creditable service.....\$208.33

B. If the officer has 10 but less than 12 years  
creditable service.....\$291.66

C. If the officer has 12 but less than 14 years  
creditable service.....\$333.33

D. If the officer has 14 but less than 18 years  
creditable service.....\$416.66

E. If the officer has 18 or more years creditable  
service.....\$500.00

4. Add new subparagraph 060305A to read:

"A. Less than 3 years creditable service is entitled to additional special pay of \$4,000 for each 12 month period."

5. Revise original subparagraphs 060305A thru D to read 060305B thru E

6. Renumber paragraph 0605 and 060501 as 0606 and 060601.

7. Add new paragraph 0605:

"SPECIAL PAY FOR ACTIVE DUTY OF RESERVE DENTAL OFFICERS"

8. Add new paragraph 060501:

"Entitlement. A Reserve dental officer on active duty for less than one year is entitled to special pay at the monthly rate of \$350 for each month of active duty, including active duty in the form of annual training, active duty for training, and active duty for special work. The amount will be prorated for periods less than one month."

9. Add new paragraph 060502

"Active Duty for More Than 30 Days But Less Than One Year, Other Than Active Duty for Training"

A. Reserve dental officers serving on active duty for more than 30 days but less than one year, other than active duty for training (37 U.S.C. Section 302f subsection (b)), are entitled to Variable Special Pay, Additional Special Pay, and Board Certified Pay at rates specified in paragraphs 0601 thru 0603 of this chapter. Payments shall be paid monthly and amounts shall be prorated for periods of less than one month. Reserve dental officers receiving Additional Special Pay under section 302f above, are not required to execute a written agreement to remain on active duty for at least one year.

B. Reserve dental officers who receive special pay under this paragraph are not entitled to special pay under paragraph 060501 for the same period of time. No dual compensation is permitted.
