FISCAL YEAR 1998

Composite hourly rates and target hour ceilings for contract administration and contract audit services to be provided by DoD activities to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) in FY 1998 are summarized below. The target hour ceilings for the Navy, the Defense Logistics Agency, and the Defense Contract Audit Agency reflect revised amounts per the Deputy Chief Financial Officer's memorandum of March 12, 1998.

Notes:

- 1/ The above rates are effective October 1, 1997.
- 2/ The Navy, DLA and DCAA are responsible for management and further distribution of the target hours ceiling under their control.
- 3/ The DoD/NASA agreement requires that reimbursements earned be monitored to determine if they are in line with annual hourly targets. Each DoD Component is to review billings at least quarterly and report any significant deviations from its assigned hourly target. DoD Components are to stay within established target ceilings. There is no requirement for reimbursement by the NASA if DoD exceeds the terms of the agreement without prior NASA approval.
