The Joint Staff major equipment includes the following programs:

- 1. The Combatant Commanders Command and Control Initiatives Program (C2IP) provides the Combatant Commands a capability to implement timely, low-cost, near-term improvements to their command and control systems, IAW CJCSI 7401.02c, 20 May 2004 "Combatant commander Command and Control Initiatives Program". The program enables the Joint Staff and Combatant Commands to solve unforeseen situations that involves procurement of new technology. Proposals must meet C2IP criteria, be validated and approved by the J-6, JCS, implemented within one year of receipt of funds, and a completion report filed within 30 days after a project has been fully implemented.
- 2. The Combating Terrorism Readiness Initiatives Fund (CbT RIF) provides a means for Combatant Commands to react to unanticipated requirements from changes in terrorist threat level or force protection doctrine or standards. The primary focus of CbT RIF is physical security equipment and physical security site improvements.
- 3. The Joint Data Support (JDS) Funding is required to continue development and support of the top- priority joint warfare models and to provide data support for the existing models.
- 4. Coalition Warrior Interoperability Demonstrations (CWID) the Command, Control, Communications, and Computer interoperability for the warrior (C4IFTW) vision has evolved into the Department's Global Information Grid (GIG) as a means to achieve information superiority, Coalition Warrior Interoperability C4 interoperability issues and provides organizing principles, technique, and procedures for achieving information superiority as envisioned by JV 2020. The GIG stresses interoperability and CWID leverages the rapid pace of C4 technology advancements. CWID is the Chairman's annual event that enables the US combatant commands, national civil authorities, and international community to investigate command, control, communications, computers, intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance (C4ISR) solutions that focus on relevant and timely objectives for enhancing coalition interoperability and exploring new partnerships. conducted in a simulated operational environment to provide context for warfighter and national civil authorities validation of those solutions. Interoperability Trials (ITs) are the activities used to address the core coalitions, and interagency interoperability objectives selected each year. ITs strive to address warfighter requirements and interoperability deficiencies. CWID is an integral component of the JV 2020 conceptual template.

- 5. Management Headquarters provides procurement funds for miscellaneous equipment purchases for the Joint Staff, including the Joint Staff Information Network (JSIN). JSIN is the network infrastructure that provides crucial decision-making information affecting military operations in support of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the Joint Staff. The JSIN satisfies office automation requirements such as collaborative planning tools, action package preparation and tracking, automated message handling, local area networking, including, desktop computers, monitors, printers, scanners, network servers, etc.
- 6. The Joint Staff Analytical Support funding was realigned from the Management Headquarters Program Element (PE) to properly reflect analytical support on the Joint Staff. This new PE encompasses several programs across multiple appropriations (Operation and Maintenance; Procurement; and Research, Development, Test and Evaluation). The programs include: Joint Training System (to include Training Transformation (T2)), Focused Logistics, Joint Collaborative Analysis (JCA) Support (formerly Joint Modeling & Simulation), Adaptive Planning and Analytic Agenda, and Functional Capabilities Board (formerly Joint Warfighting Capability Assessment (JWCA)).

Remarks:

CbT RIF funds emergency and emergent high-priority CbT requirements. It provides the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and Combatant Commanders a means to quickly respond to unanticipated requirements from changes in terrorist threat level, force protection doctrine or standards, and other critical Combatant Command Antiterrorism requirements. The primary focus of CbT RIF is on physical security equipment, physical security site improvements, and security investigative matters. Increases in FY06-08 are a result of increased force protection levels since the 11 September 2001 terrorist attacks on the United States and the creation of USNORTHCOM. GWOT has dramatically increased demand for AT requirements, including providing defensive capabilities against improvised explosive devices for both fixed and mobile forces/assets. All Combatant Commanders areas of operations are experiencing increased force protection threat levels, including units in the continental United States.

FY 2006 Accomplishments:

CENTCOM: Anti-vehicle barriers, electronic sensory system, explosive detection equipment, cargo inspection systems, barriers, closed circuit television systems, barriers, forward looking Infrared (FLIR) cameras, safe haven doors.

NORTHCOM: Fragmentation film for windows, perimeter lighting, day / night camera system, mass notification system, barriers, bollards, joint sector command center, intrusion detection systems, flightline fencing, gates.

JFCOM: Mass notification systems, blast resistant windows, vehicle inspection area, entry control points.

EUCOM: Intrusion detection systems, IR motion sensors, explosive detection equipment, bollards, barriers, entry control points, overwatch towers, perimeter lighting, perimeter fencing, blast resistant glass.

CWID provides focus and visibility into resolving coalition Command, Control, Communications, and Computer (C4) interoperability issues and provides organizing principles, techniques, and procedures for achieving information superiority as envisioned by Joint Vision 2020 (JV 2020). The Joint Staff's Global Information Grid (GIG) stresses interoperability and CWID leverages the rapid pace of C4 technology advancements.

CWID is the Chairman's annual event that enables the U.S. combatant commands, national civil authorities, and international community to investigate command, control, communications, computers, intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance (C4ISR) solutions that focus on relevant and timely objectives for enhancing coalition interoperability and exploring new partnerships.
