<p>This action transfers \$9.977 million from Procurement, Marine Corps, 99/01, to Other Procurement, Navy, 99/01, to properly execute the funds. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 105-262, the DoD Appropriations Act, 1999, and section 1001 of Public Law 105-261, the Strom Thurmond National Defense Authorization Act for FY 1999. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, and is not reflected in the FY 2000 President's budget. This action does not affect Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities (TIARA), Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP), or the National Foreign Intelligence Program (NFIP).</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> The AN/AVS-6 Night Vision Goggle OMNI IV device is used in rotary wing and fixed wing platforms as a situational awareness and mission enhancement for night operations. Because Navy and Marine Corps aviation night vision devices are budgeted in the Aviation Life Support line item in Other Procurement, Navy, and the Congress added funds for this program in Procurement, Marine Corps, 99/01, a transfer is necessary to properly execute these funds. The amount for reprogramming has been adjusted for congressional undistributed reductions.</p>
