<p>This internal reprogramming action transfers \$198.2 million from the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund to the Components' FY 1999 Operation and Maintenance (O&amp;M) and Procurement appropriations for expenses directly related to overseas contingency operations. These transfers are made pursuant to transfer authority contained in Public Law 106-31, the FY 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action affects Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP); it does not affect the National Foreign Intelligence Program or the Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities (TIARA) program. This action is not reflected in the FY 2000 President's budget.</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> The FY 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act (P.L. 106-31) appropriated \$3,907.3 million. Previous reprogramming actions transferred \$3,189.7 million of this funding to the respective appropriations. This action transfers an additional \$198.2 million for expenses directly related to Overseas Contingency Operations by U.S. military forces and to meet identified Kosovo requirements for current and ongoing contingency operations in FY 1999.</p>
