<p>This internal reprogramming action realigns resources within the Research Development, Test and Evaluation, Army (RDT&E,A), 98/99, appropriation from the Force XXI Initiatives - Warfighting Rapid Acquisition Program (WRAP) to existing Army programs. It also transfers RDT&E,A, 98/99, resources from WRAP to Other Procurement, Army, 98/00, for procurement of the Analysis and Control Team (ACT) Enclave system. This action does not represent a change from the purpose or funding approved by the Congress. The action requires the use of general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 105-56, the FY 1998 DoD Appropriations Act, and section 1001 of Public Law 105-85, the FY 1998 National Defense Authorization Act. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. This action affects the Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities, but does not affect National Foreign Intelligence Programs (NFIP) or Joint Military Intelligence Programs.</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> The Analysis and Control Team (ACT) is an intelligence node within the brigade that integrates near real time intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance data collected primarily from the JSTARS Common Ground Station and the Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Tactical Common Station. The Analysis and Control Team Enclave (ACT-E) is the equipment automating the ACT operations. An ACT-E is a HMMWV-mounted shelter with digital communications, embedded local area network and router architecture, two ASAS remote workstations and accompanying components. These funds will complete the integration and procure eight ACT-E equipment sets for the First Digitized Corp.</p>
