<p>This action transfers \$243.108 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, FY 1999, appropriation to various appropriations for drug interdiction and counterdrug activities, consistent with the provisions of Public Law 105-262, the FY 1999 DoD Appropriations Act, and Public Law 105-277, the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Appropriations Act, 1999. This action affects Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP) and has the concurrence of the Director for Central Intelligence. It does not affect the National Foreign Intelligence Program or the Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities. Realignment of funds between counterdrug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, Drug Enforcement Policy and Support. These transfers are not reflected in the FY 2000/2001 President's budget.</p>
