<p>This internal reprogramming action transfers \$8.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide appropriation enacted by Public Law 105-277, Division B, Chapter 2 of Title II (Antiterrorism) of the FY 1999 Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act. This transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action uses special transfer authority provided in Public Law 105-277. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. This action does not affect the National Foreign Intelligence Program, the Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities (TIARA), or Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP). This action is not reflected in the FY 2000/2001 President's budget.</p>
