<p>This reprogramming transfers \$3.4 million from Procurement, Defense-Wide, 99/01, to Research, Development, Test and Evaluation, Defense-Wide (RDT&E,DW), 99/00; and realigns \$12.5 million within RDT&E,DW, 99/00. It is submitted for prior approval as it proposes to use general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 105-262, the FY 1999 DoD Appropriations Act, and section 1001 of Public Law 105-261, the Strom Thurmond National Defense Authorization Act for FY 1999. This action is for higher priority items than that for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not been denied by the Congress. This action does not affect Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP), Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities (TIARA), or the National Foreign Intelligence Program (NFIP). It is reflected in the FY 2000/2001 President's budget.*</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> The United States Atlantic Command (USACOM) was designated Executive Agent for Joint Experimentation effective October 1, 1998. Additional funds are required to execute the approved FY 1999 Joint Experimentation Campaign Plan and fund the infrastructure and technology support required to carry out these experiments. The additional funding is required to conduct the approved experimentation plan in FY 1999. Specifically, funds will be used to plan, execute and assess Attack Operations of Critical Mobile Targets, Bio Centric Operations and Counters, Space Operations, Weapons of Mass Effect, Autonomous Operations, Global Power Projection, Joint Contingency Force Operations and Common Relevant Operational Picture. In addition, funds will be used to stand-up the Joint Battle Laboratory Infrastructure (personnel and facilities) necessary to accomplish the approved FY 1999 Experimentation Plan.</p>
