This reprogramming action realigns \$9.5 million from various Air Force RDT&E programs to the Manned Reconnaissance Air Force RDT&E program. This reprogramming action is submitted because the increase to the Manned Reconnaissance program exceeds the below threshold reprogramming limits. It reprograms funding in support of a higher priority item, based on unforeseen military requirements, than that for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action will fund an immediate and critical upgrade to the electronic warfare self-defense capabilities of the U-2. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. This action affects the Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP; it does not affect Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities (TIARA) or the National Foreign Intelligence Program (NFIP). This action is not reflected in the FY 2000/2001 President's budget.
