This internal reprogramming action transfers \$181.3 million from the Military Construction Transfer Fund provided in Public Law 106-31, the 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act. This transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated and does not require the use of general transfer authority. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not denied any of the items. This action will be reflected in the FY 2001 President's budget.

Explanation: The 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, P.L. 106-31, provided \$475 million for emergency expenses incurred by U.S. military forces in support of overseas operations. The FY 2000 Military Construction Conference Report 106-266 directed the Department to fund the European military construction projects with funds appropriated to the Military Construction Transfer Fund (MCTF). The current reprogramming requirement for \$181.3 million will realign funds from the MCTF to the Services' military construction accounts to execute the European military construction projects.
