<p><u>Explanation:</u> This action transfers funds appropriated to the Department of Defense for environmental restoration efforts in FY 2000 from the various Defense Environmental Restoration transfer appropriations to the Components' appropriations for execution. These amounts include funds for Army, Navy, Air Force, and Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to reimburse the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for completed cleanup at the Fresno Drum site in California per arbitration by the Department of Justice and agreed to by each of the DoD Components and as authorized in section 326 of Public Law 106-65, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2000. The following amounts are to be deposited by the respective Component to the Fresno Drum Special Account within the Hazardous Substance Superfund established by section 9507 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. At the time funds are transferred, each Component is required to provide notice to EPA Region IX that such payment has been made. In accordance with the agreement, funds must be paid within 60 days of the enactment of FY 2000 appropriation to avoid fines assessed to the Department of Defense: Army (\$147,900.75), Navy (\$214,066.87), Air Force (\$194,606.25), and DLA (\$221,851.13).</p>
