<p>This internal reprogramming action transfers \$57.1 million from the Military Training, Equipment, and Associated Support Transfer Fund, Defense, 99/00, to the Components' FY 2000 Operation and Maintenance appropriations to meet the most urgent readiness-related requirements. This action is consistent with the provisions and authority enacted by Title II, Chapter 3, section 2010 of Public Law 106-31, the 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This transfer authority is in addition to other transfer authorities. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.</p>
