<p>This internal reprogramming action transfers \$42.7 million between various Operation & Maintenance (O&M) and Military Personnel appropriations for the purpose of redistributing the foreign currency exchange rates reductions included in Public Law 106-79, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2000, on an equitable basis based on the exchange rates approved for execution. These realignments are reflected in the FY 2001 President's budget. The realignments require the use of general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-79, and section 1001 of Public Law 106-65, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2000.</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> The FY 2000 DoD Appropriations Act (P.L. 106-79) reduced Operation and Maintenance (O&M) and Military Personnel appropriations by a total of \$171.0 million based on anticipated foreign currency rate gains. Further, the congressional distribution of the reduction by appropriation is not consistent with the actual impact of such a change in foreign currency exchange rates. To correct the distribution of the reduction, this reprogramming uses general transfer authority to redistribute \$42.700 million of the congressional reduction.</p>
