This transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action uses transfer authority pursuant to Division B, Title I, Chapter 1 of P.L. 105-277, the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not denied any of the funds.</p>
