Explanation: The Environmental Quality Technology (EQT) program is focused on the validation of technology to exploit environmentally-acceptable technology throughout the Army and DoD and to transfer that technology to industry. It will support initial training on how to use the technology and will foster efforts to transfer the technology as appropriate. This validation program will address environmental quality technology for pollution prevention projects initially and conservation, compliance, and restoration projects eventually as other projects are resourced. In the FY 1999 National Defense Authorization Act conference report, the conferees directed the Army to establish an environmental quality demonstration/validation program element to manage funds for ongoing pollution prevention research and development initiatives, to begin in FY 2000. The new program element has already been established in the FY 2001 President's Budget. This reprogramming establishes the new program element in FY 2000 as directed, and transfers funding for environmental quality to the new program element for proper execution. This action complies with congressional direction on the execution of the EQT program.
