<p><u>Explanation:</u> In FY 1999, the Congress provided \$50 million for specific upgrades to maximize the B-2 effectiveness. The Air Force identified replacement requirements for the entire \$50 million in its June 8, 1999, letter to the Congress. The congressional committees have approved the use of these funds for the replacement items. These funds provide for a modification using Alternate High Frequency Materials. The balance of this amount has already been provided to the Air Force for execution.</p>
