<p>This internal reprogramming action transfers \$200 million from the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund to FY 2000 Operation and Maintenance, Procurement, and Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation appropriations to be used for items that meet a critical readiness or sustainability need. Items included are based on the review of Kosovo Lessons Learned and include recommendations of the Defense Resources Board. These transfers are made pursuant to transfer authority contained in Public Law 106-31, the 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, and also reflect congressional action in section 8134 of Public Law 106-79, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2000, concerning the use of Supplemental funding. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.</p>
