<p>This internal reprogramming action transfers \$202.7 million from the Military Construction Transfer Fund provided in Public Law 106-31, the 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act. This transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated and does not require the use of general transfer authority. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and none of the items has been denied by the Congress. This action is not reflected in the FY 2000 President's Budget.</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> The 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, P.L. 106-31, provided \$475 million in contingent emergency funding to the Department of Defense's Military Construction Transfer Fund (MCTF) for emergency expenses incurred by U.S. military forces in support of overseas operations. The FY 2000 Military Construction Conference Report, 106-266, directed the Department to fund military construction projects with funds appropriated to the MCTF.</p> <p>This action transfers \$202.7 million from the MCTF to the Services' Military Construction appropriations to execute military construction projects.</p>
