This internal reprogramming action accomplishes two functions. First, it transfers \$230 million back to the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund -- \$115 million each from the Navy and Air Force. These funds were previously transferred to the Navy and the Air Force to support contingency operational requirements; however, they are being transferred back to finance the pressing funding shortfall being experienced by the Army and the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) for Kosovo operations pending passage and receipt of additional funds from the Kosovo emergency supplemental request. Secondly, this internal reprogramming transfers the \$230 million from the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund to the Army and to DISA to finance pressing Kosovo shortfalls. The purpose of these actions is to transfer these funds to the appropriate accounts to meet the most urgent contingency requirements consistent with the provisions and authority contained in the appropriation for the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund, Public Law 106-79, the FY 2000 DoD Appropriations Act. This reprogramming action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated.
