<u>Explanation</u>: The Congress added \$1 million in the Chemical/Biological Defense Program in Procurement, Defense-Wide, 00/02, for M40/M42 Protective Mask Reclamation. The funds will be used to unpack, inspect, test, and refurbish 38,000 masks to issuable (War Reserve) condition. These requirements are more appropriately funded in Operation and Maintenance rather than Procurement. Therefore, this action transfers \$0.913 million (amount remaining after congressional undistributed reductions) from the Procurement, Defense-Wide, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, appropriation for proper execution.
