The realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. The program is a congressional special interest item. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> The AN/PAS-13 is a multi-purpose Thermal Weapon Sight designed to be mounted on all infantry individual and crew served weapons. It is a GEN II Thermal Device which significantly improves dismounted infantry operation capability by increasing range and enabling both day and night vision through smoke, fog, battlefield obscurants and in extremely low light levels such as under triple canopy jungle. The Congress provided an increase of \$40.0 million for Night Vision Devices, which included \$3.5 million for AN/PAS-13. These funds should be executed from the Thermal Weapon Sight budget line.</p>
