<p>This action transfers \$35.400 million from Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, to various Components' appropriations consistent with the provisions of Division B of Public Law 106-246, the Emergency Supplemental Act, 2000, and pursuant to transfer authority provided by that Act. This reprogramming action supports the effort to train and provide equipment to the three Colombian Counternarcotic Battalions and the Colombian Counternarcotic Brigade Headquarters. Realignment of funds between counter-drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, Drug Enforcement Policy and Support (DEP&S).</p>
