<p>This internal reprogramming action reprograms \$682,000 from Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide (O&amp;M, D-W), FY 2000, for the purpose of correctly aligning funds added by the Congress for automated Emergency Notification systems. The transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-79, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2000; and section 1001 of Public Law 106-65, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2000. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> The Congress added \$1 million (reduced to \$964,000 by the across-the-board rescission (PL 106-113)) to the O&amp;M, D-W appropriation for Emergency Notification. According to the House Report 106-244, page 95, the funding is for fielding an automated emergency notification system similar to that in the Army Operation Center "to other organizations in the Department with similar notification requirements." The OUSD(Policy) Continuity of Operations Office has devised a plan that fulfills a requirement for the Office of the Secretary of Defense, the Defense Information Systems Agency, the Joint Staff, and the Services. All but the Services' requirements will be funded in O&amp;M, D-W. This reprogramming action realigns \$682,000 from the O&amp;M, D-W appropriation to the Services' O&amp;M accounts for execution.</p>
