<p>This internal reprogramming action is in two parts. Part one transfers \$2.497 million from Procurement, Defense-Wide, 00/02, and Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 00/01, back to the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund. Part two transfers \$7.660 million from the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund to other accounts for proper execution. This action transfers these funds to meet the most urgent contingency requirements consistent with the provisions and authority enacted by Public Law (P.L.) 106-31, the 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, and P.L. 106-246, the Emergency Supplemental Act, 2000. Transfer authority for this action is contained in P.L. 106-31 and P.L. 106-246, and is in addition to other transfer authorities. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated and is not reflected in the FY 2001 President's Budget.</p>
