The transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. These funds continue to support counter-drug programs. This action uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-79, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2000; and section 1001 of Public Law 106-65, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2000. The action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.</p>
