Explanation: The Air Force has a requirement for 33 Rubidium Clocks for the Block IIF Global Positioning System satellites. Parts for all 33 were advance procured under a cost saving agreement. Six are in production and are financed within the acquisition line. The remaining 27 need to be assembled and financed by a new advance procurement line in advance of satellite production. This will keep the only supplier's necessary personnel in place thereby avoiding a significant (\$10 million restart costs alone) increase in cost. These funds were appropriated in the Global Positioning (Space) line item for this purpose, but require realignment because the clocks are advance procurement requirements. The total cost is \$9 million and the remaining balance (\$2 million in FY 2001; \$2 million in FY 2002; \$3 million in FY 2003) is included in the FY 2001 President's Budget.
