<p><u>Explanation:</u> Funds were provided in the FY 2000 DoD Appropriations Act to establish and support 17 Military Support Detachments [Weapons of Mass Destruction Support to Civil Authorities Teams (WMD-CSTs), previously named Rapid Assessment and Initial Detection (RAID) Teams]. Establishment of the teams requires procurement of a variety of equipment, including Mobile Analytical Laboratory Systems, Unified Command Suites, other operational, communications, and computer equipment as well as specialized survey and protective equipment. Section 8111 of the FY 2000 DoD Appropriations Act provided increases in the funding by an amount sufficient to fully fund the establishment of 17 additional WMD-CSTs in FY 2000. However, the funds need to be realigned between appropriations for proper execution. Therefore, the WMD-CST funds appropriated to the Operation and Maintenance and National Guard Personnel appropriations, which are in excess to the WMD-CST team requirements in those appropriations, must be transferred to the Procurement appropriations to procure the required equipment for the additional teams.</p>
