<p>This action is submitted for prior approval of a new start program within the Miniaturized Munitions Capability (MMC) program, to begin development of a 500 pound MK-82 Joint Direct Attack Munition (JDAM) for fixed and relocatable targets. It reprograms funds for higher priority unforeseen military requirements, than the requirements for which originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. This action uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 105-262, the DoD Appropriations Act, 1999, and section 1001 of Public Law 105-261, the Strom Thurmond National Defense Authorization Act for FY 1999. This action is not reflected in the FY 2001 President's Budget.</p>
