This internal reprogramming action transfers \$69.950 million from Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, X, to Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, FY 2001; Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 01/02; and Procurement, Defense-Wide, 01/03. Part one uses transfer authority pursuant to Division B, Title I, Chapter 1 of Public Law (P.L.) 105-277, the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999. Part two uses transfer authority pursuant to section 8119 of P.L. 106-259, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2001. These transfers do not change the purpose for which the funds were appropriated. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not denied any of the funds.
