This reprogramming action transfers \$9.560 million from Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, to Operation and Maintenance, Army, FY 2001, and Operation and Maintenance, Navy, FY 2001, for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities consistent with the provisions and authority enacted under Division B, Title III, Public Law 106-246, the Emergency Supplemental Act, 2000. This transfer authority is in addition to other transfer authorities. Realignment of funds between counter-drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, Drug Enforcement Policy and Support (DEP&S).
