This internal reprogramming action transfers \$10.2 million from Other Procurement, Navy, 01/03, to Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy, 01/05, for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2001, and section 1001 of Public Law 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. This transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and has not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: Funds were budgeted and appropriated in the Other Procurement, Navy (OPN) appropriation for the nonrecurring engineering efforts for the AN/WSQ-9 because it was scheduled to be backfitted on the Los Angeles Class Submarines. OPN is the correct appropriation to procure the nonrecurring efforts, the new system, and the changes to existing submarines to accept the new system. However, the first installation of the AN/WSQ-9 system is now scheduled for incorporation into the third Virginia Class Submarine, which begins construction in FY 2001. These efforts are more properly financed in the Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy appropriation that pays for submarine construction. This action therefore transfers the funds for proper execution.
