This internal reprogramming action transfers \$3.963 million from Weapons Procurement, Navy, 01/03, to Procurement of Ammunition, Navy and Marine Corps, 01/03, for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law (P.L.) 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2001, and section 1001 of P.L. 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.



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Explanation: In FY 2001, the Congress added \$4 million in the Weapons Procurement, Navy appropriation for the Shoulder-Launched Multipurpose Assault Weapon (SMAW) Common Practice Round. The procurement of SMAW rockets is more appropriately funded in the Procurement of Ammunition, Navy and Marine Corps appropriation. Therefore, this action transfers the funds for proper execution. This reprogramming does not alter the congressional intent for use of these funds. A reduction of \$37,000, associated with P.L. 106-259, section 8086 and P.L. 106-554, section 1403, has been applied to the appropriated funding.
