This internal reprogramming action transfers \$1.292 million from Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, FY 2001, into various FY 2001 Reserve and National Guard Personnel appropriations for the Department's Innovative Readiness Training (IRT) Civil Military Program. This action uses transfer authority contained in section 8075 of Public Law 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act FY 2001, to meet personnel requirements for the Innovative Readiness Training Program. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and has not previously been denied by the Congress.
