This internal reprogramming action transfers \$3 million from Other Procurement, Navy, 01/03, to Operation and Maintenance, Navy, FY 2001. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2001, and section 1001 of Public Law 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. Reclassification is required to properly execute funds in accordance with congressional intent. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and has not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: This item is a congressional special interest item. In FY 2001, Congress added \$3 million to the Other Procurement, Navy appropriation for electronic recruiting kiosks. The Chief of the Navy Recruiting Command is developing an electronic recruiting kiosk as a joint program for all military services. Potential recruits will be able to investigate military opportunities and explore entry requirements before the first interaction with a recruiter. Mobile electronic recruiting kiosks will be strategically placed at high traffic locations such as shopping malls, sports arenas, and air shows.

The Navy has determined that obtaining the kiosks via a service contract will be more cost-effective than purchasing them. Therefore, this action realigns the funding added by the Congress from the Other Procurement, Navy appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Navy appropriation to obtain the recruiting kiosks. This reprogramming does not alter the congressional intent for use of these funds.
