This internal reprogramming action transfers funding from the Military Personnel, Army (MPA), FY 2001, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army (OMA), FY 2001, appropriation for proper program execution pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2001; and section 1001 of Public Law 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. The transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: Beginning on June 1, 2001, one Cold Weather Field Jacket (CWFJ) (of two total issued) will be eliminated from the MPA-funded enlisted clothing bag and will no longer be initially issued to the basic trainees at the Army's five Basic Training Centers (BTCs). The second CWFJ has been determined to be only necessary during cold weather months at BTCs. Therefore, beginning on October 1, 2001, the Clothing Issue Facilities (CIFs) at BTCs will issue additional CWFJs during the cold weather months and then collect the jackets from the basic trainees at the end of training for reissuance. This action transfers the estimated savings from the elimination of the additional CWFJ from the enlisted clothing bag to the OMA-funded CIFs to fund a one-time purchase of CWFJs for initial stockage at BTCs.
