This internal reprogramming action transfers funds from Procurement, Defense-Wide, 01/03, to Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide 01/02, to properly execute congressionally added funds to develop the Integrated Bridge System (IBS). This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of PL 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2001; and section 1001 of P.L. 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. This action involves a congressional special interest item.

Explanation: The Congress added \$4.0 million in the SOF Combatant Craft Systems line item to develop, procure, and install the Integrated Bridge System in support of the High Speed Assault Craft (HSAC) and Naval Surface Warfare Rigid Inflatable Boat (NSW RIB). The integration and testing segments of this program should be financed with Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation funding instead of Procurement. This action transfers \$2.0 million for HSAC and \$0.5 million for NSW RIB necessary for proper execution. The remaining Procurement funds will be used to buy and install the system after it is designed, tested, and approved.
