This reprogramming action realigns funds within Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 01/02, to properly execute funds added by the Congress for Miniaturized Munitions Capability (MMC). It does not change the purpose for which Congress appropriated the funds. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by Congress.

Explanation: The Congress added \$12.0 million in the FY 2001 DoD Appropriations Act to accelerate development of a 250 pound MMC variant, which the Department will implement as the Small Diameter Bomb. The Congress also added \$13.0 million in the FY 2001 Supplemental for development of this weapon. The Small Diameter Bomb recently received its own Program Element (PE) and it is therefore appropriate to transfer the funds initially added by Congress to the appropriate PE for proper execution and ease of management.
