This internal reprogramming action returns to the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund (OCOTF) a total of \$2.050 million previously issued but now identified as excess to requirements. This funding action is required to meet the most urgent contingency requirements consistent with the provisions and authority enacted by Public Law 106-554, the Consolidated Appropriations Act for FY 2001, and P.L. 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2001. This transfer authority is in addition to other transfer authorities. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not been previously denied by the Congress.
