SUBJECT: Transfer of Funds into the Homeowners Assistance Fund, Defense

This memorandum provides instructions for implementation of a transfer of \$25.190 million into the Homeowners Assistance Fund, Defense.

The transfer of \$25.190 million from the Base Realignment and Closure Account, Part IV, to the Homeowners Assistance Fund, Defense, is approved for implementation on November 21, 2000, contingent upon congressional approval. The 21-day notification of the transfer to the Congress was provided by USD(C) letter dated October 30, 2000; November 20, 2000, is the last day of that notification period. Transfer authority is provided by section 126 of Public Law 106-246, the Military Construction Appropriations Act, 2001.

The attached data sheet provides instructions for the transfer and apportionment of funds.
