This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it involves the Joint Collection Management Tools (JCMT) program, a congressional special interest program within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 00/01 appropriation. The action transfers funds between the Army and the Navy. It continues the development of capabilities for which the funds were originally appropriated but assigns them to a different organization. This action requires the use of general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005, of Public Law 106-79, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2000, and section 1001 of Public Law 106-65, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2000. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. It is not reflected in the FY 2001 President's Budget.

Explanation: The Army will conclude the JCMT program and close its Product Management Office (PMO) at the end of FY 2000. The client-server architecture and legacy code of JCMT has made it technically inefficient for integration/segmentation with the Global Command and Control System (GCCS), Integrated Imagery, and Intelligence (GCCS-I3) system. The Army's JCMT funds are being transferred to the Navy to continue development of a Collection Management Mission Application (CMMA) for the Global Command and Control System (GCCS) and its intelligence component, Integrated Imagery and Intelligence (GCCS-I3). The GCCS intelligence application interfaces joint operational and theater collection management with national collection management.
