This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law (P.L.) 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2001; and section 1001 of P.L. 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. This action transfers \$25.2 million from Procurement, Defense-Wide, 01/03, to Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 01/02, to cover increased development costs for the Advanced SEAL Delivery System (ASDS) Vehicle 1 delivery. This action reprograms funding in support of a higher priority item, based on unforeseen military requirements, than that for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. This action is partially reflected in the FY 2002 President's Budget.

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Explanation: While undergoing Deep Water Testing at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, ASDS Vehicle 1 experienced a high rate of systems failure that has resulted in unexpected downtime and a schedule slip of 12 months. Because of this schedule delay, more research and development funding is needed in FY 2001.
