This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2001, and section 1001 of Public Law 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. It reprograms funding in support of a higher priority item, based on unforeseen military requirements, than that for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.

The contract supported by this reprogramming action will allow the DISA to support troop deployments and other missions with global secure connectivity to the Defense Information System Network.

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Explanation: The Information Assurance Certificate Authority Workstation (CAW) software upgrades (Release 3.0) and the Security Test and Evaluation, as well as the DMS Integration Tests (DIT), were accomplished using FY 2000 procurement funding. Given that these efforts have already been fully funded using prior year funds, the FY 2001 funding that was originally budgeted and appropriated for these efforts is no longer required and is excess to program requirements. For this reason, these funds can be transferred to the Iridium program without impact to the CAW and the DIT program.
