This reprogramming action transfers \$12.224 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, FY 2002, appropriation to the Army and Air Force National Guard for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities consistent with the provisions of Public Law 107-117, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2002. This transfer authority is in addition to other transfer authorities provided by this Act. The Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense, Counternarcotics Execution Plan dated March 4, 2002, includes project code detail for these transfers. Realignment of funds between Counter-Drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, Counternarcotics.
