This action transfers \$76 million from the Other Procurement, Navy, 02/04, appropriation to the Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy, 02/06, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2002, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the National Defense Authorizations Act for FY 2002. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and has not been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: Funding supports the TRIDENT Ship, Submersible, Ballistic, Nuclear (SSBN) D-5 backfit. One C-4 TRIDENT submarine is scheduled to be refueled in both FY 2005 and FY 2006. Each submarine will also be converted to carry the TRIDENT II D-5 missile. These conversions are currently funded in Other Procurement, Navy. However, Navy policy is to fund all work conducted in a Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy (SCN) availability in the SCN appropriation. These conversions will be executed during SSBN Engineering Refueling Overhauls, an SCN availability. This transfer does not affect the scope of work to be conducted in FY 2002, but it is required to finance the work effort from the correct appropriation.
