This internal reprogramming action transfers \$1.7 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Navy, FY 2002, appropriation to the Weapons Procurement, Navy, 02/04, appropriation. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2002, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2002. Reclassification is required to properly execute funds in accordance with congressional intent. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: This item is a congressional special interest item. In FY 2002, Congress added \$1.7 million within the Operation and Maintenance, Navy appropriation for AN/DSM-156 Missile Test Set Upgrades. The AN/DSM-156 Missile Test Set Upgrade is designated for centralized management and asset control. Accordingly, this upgrade is more appropriately funded in the Weapons Procurement, Navy appropriation. Therefore, a reclassification reprogramming is necessary to execute these funds in the proper account. This reprogramming does not alter the congressional intent for use of these funds.
