This internal reprogramming action transfers \$8.465 million from the Other Procurement, Navy, 02/04, appropriation to the Aircraft Procurement, Navy, 02/04 appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2002, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2002. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: In FY 2002, \$8.465 million to support Airborne Mine Countermeasures (AMCM) equipment for the MH-60S aircraft was appropriated to the Other Procurement, Navy appropriation consistent with the budget request. However, the appropriate procurement account for the required mission kits is the Aircraft Procurement, Navy appropriation. This reclassification reprogramming is necessary to execute these funds in the proper account. This reprogramming does not alter the congressional intent for use of these funds.
